

MEMO
according to the Environmental Management System (EMS)
for employees of contractors performing work on the territory of
JSC "Chepetsky Mechanical Plant"

For effective activities in the field of environmental protection, CMP JSC operates an Environmental Management System (EMS) in accordance with the requirements of GOST R ISO 14001.

The EMS of CMP JSC is a set of measures aimed at reducing and preventing negative impact on the environment.

The environmental protection requirements established at CMP JSC apply to the personnel of the enterprise, as well as employees of contractors performing work on the territory of CMP JSC.

In this regard, employees of contractors are obliged:

- to know the requirements of the Environmental Policy of CMP JSC and TVEL JSC, to carry out their work in such a way as to prevent environmental pollution;

- to carry out work in compliance with the requirements of environmental protection, including the requirements established at CMP JSC.

CMP JSC has identified significant environmental aspects, associated environmental risks and requirements, departing from which may lead to negative impact on the environment and humans.

Significant environmental aspects of CMP JSC include:

- emissions into the atmosphere of pollutants in shop No. 80 and radioactive substances in shops No. 10, 54;

- accidents and contingency / emergency situations in workshops No. 05, 10, 11, 54, 60, 80, 85;

- the impact of physical factors (noise, electromagnetic radiation, ionizing radiation) at the border of the sanitary protection zone of the enterprise;

- past pollution of territories (ash and slag from coal combustion, natural radionuclides).

The environmental risks of CMP JSC include:

- exceeding the standards for emissions, discharges of pollutants into the environment, production and consumption waste;

- occurrence of accidents and contingency / emergency situations;

- exceeding the standards of physical impact on the environment;

- pollution of environmental objects and exposure to ionizing radiation from contaminated areas.

To manage environmental risks and environmental impact on the environment, CMP JSC has developed and implemented risk management measures by meeting the established requirements and rules in the field of environmental protection.

Therefore, when performing work on the territory of CMP JSC, you must comply with the following rules:

- to carry out all work in accordance with technological instructions, current procedures and instructions for your type of activity, as well as in accordance with the requirements of contracts;

- to prevent spills, leaks of fuels and lubricants, cutting fluids, technological solutions, paints and varnishes and other harmful chemical and radioactive substances, their entry into soil, water, sewer drainage networks;

- to use road-building equipment and vehicles that have passed the established control of the content of harmful substances in exhaust gases;

- to collect and accumulate production and consumption waste in specially designated places. Avoid unauthorized accumulation (storage) of waste in places where work is performed;

- promptly carry out the removal of the generated waste after completion of work;

- do not wash vehicles on the territory of CMP JSC.

Employees of organizations performing work on the territory of CMP JSC are responsible for the implementation of the listed rules.

The effectiveness of the Environmental Management System of CMP JSC and the reduction of negative impact on the environment depend on your compliance with the environmental protection requirements, including the requirements established at CMP JSC.

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
